



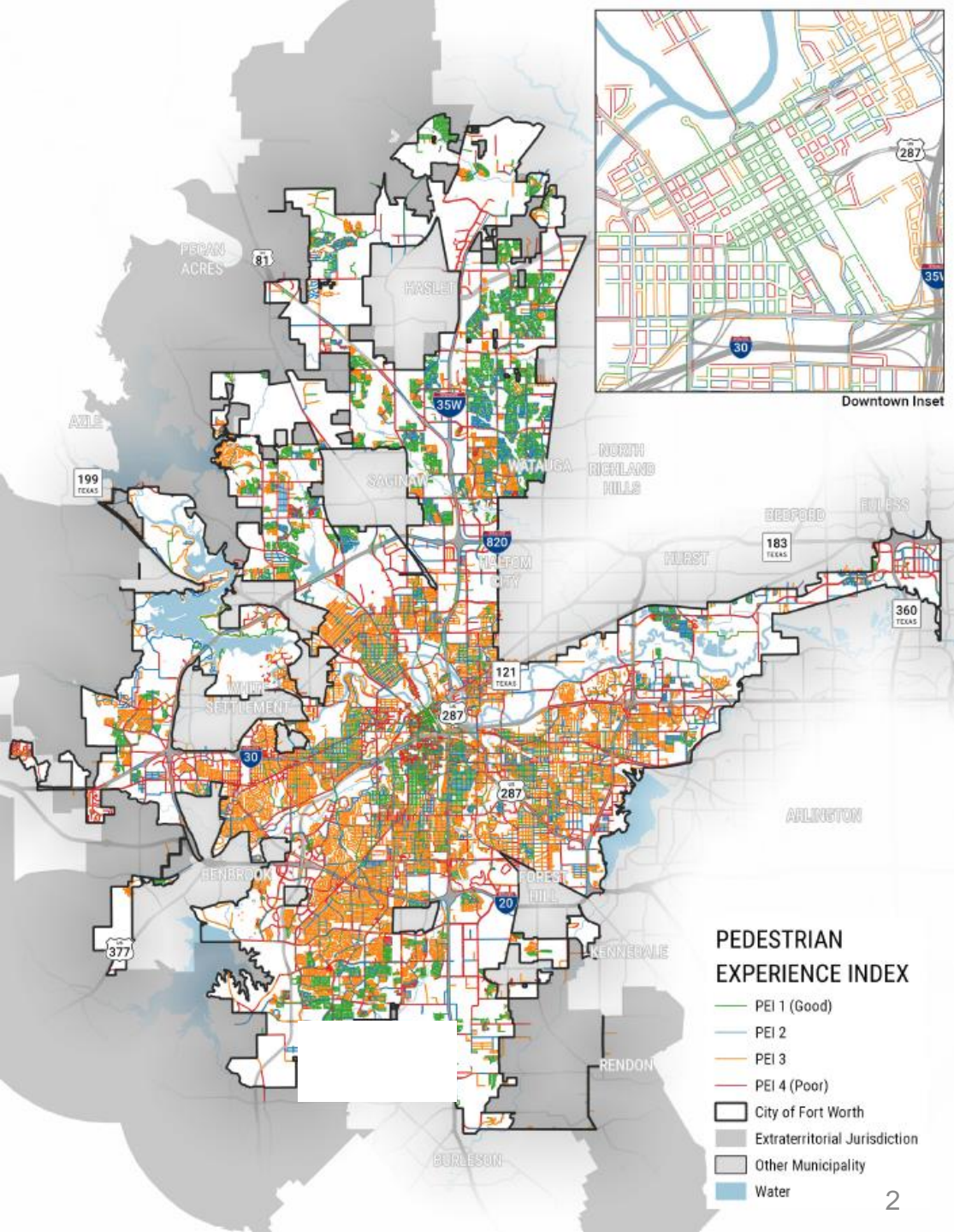

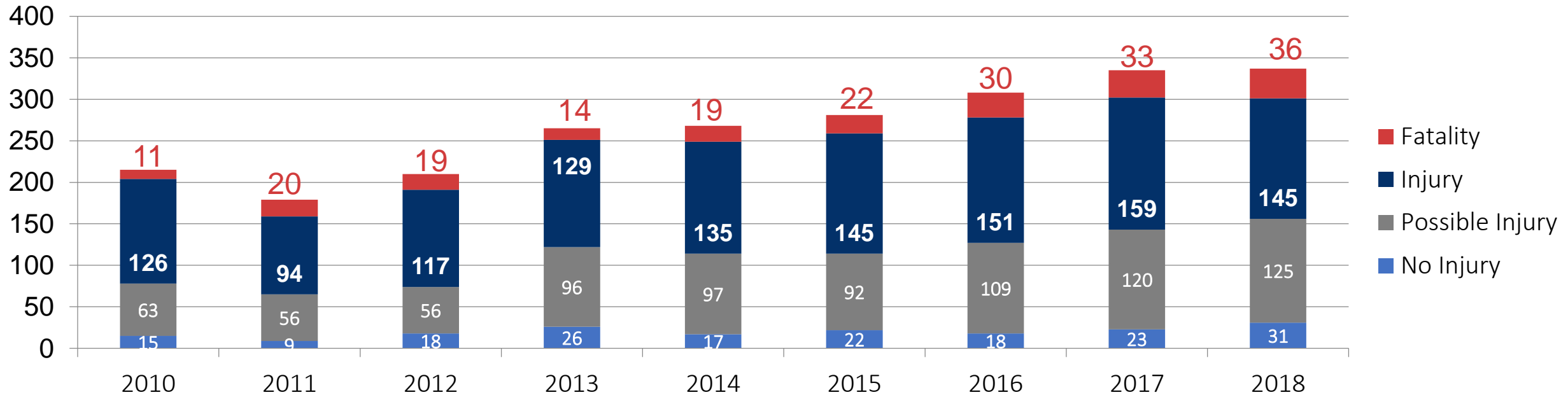

Planning Projects Underway

- Complete Streets Implementation Plan
 - Process and policy improvements to institutionalize complete streets
- Comprehensive Sidewalk Policy
 - Pedestrian First Policy
 - Repealing property owner maintenance requirement
 - Design standards
 - Waivers or Fee-in-Lieu
- Vision Zero Policy
- Implementation of Race and Culture Recommendations
 - Erase institutional racism through policy and funding recommendations
- Transit Moves Fort Worth
 - Plan for transit growth in Fort Worth from a City lens

Lessons Learned

- Policies and plans aren't effective if there isn't a plan to implement and change process
- Understanding the needs of the community is critical
- Equity!
