

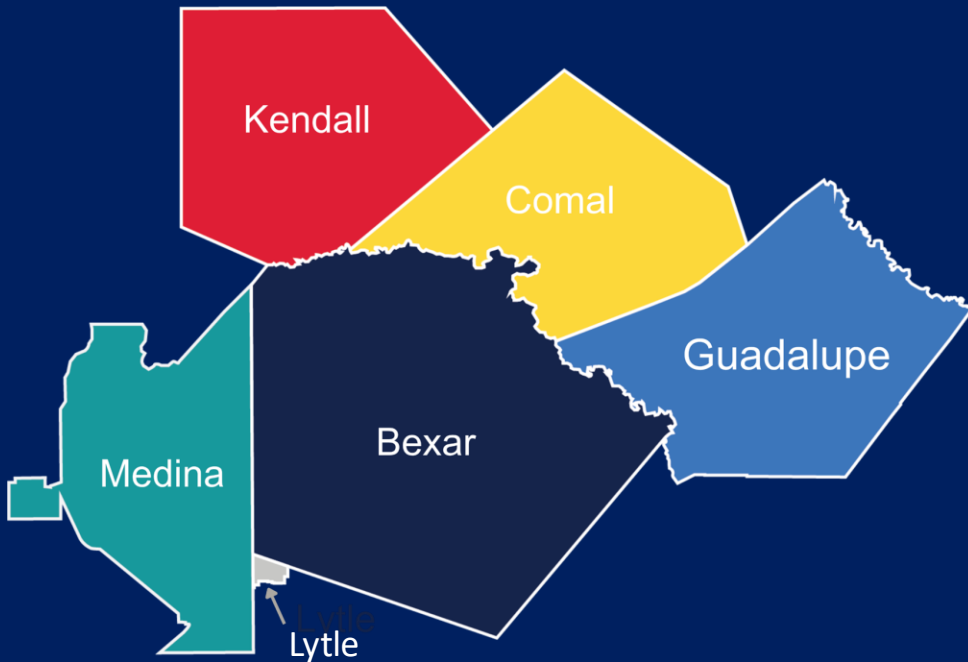

Who is AAMPO?



The Alamo Area Metropolitan Planning Organization (AAMPO) is a federally-mandated agency that guides regional transportation planning by coordinating between the **public, local, state, and federal agencies** for **federal transportation programs and funding**.

AAMPO develops transportation plans, selects and approves projects for federal funds based on regional priorities, and administer programs to improve **mobility, safety and performance**.

What is a Walkable Community Workshop?

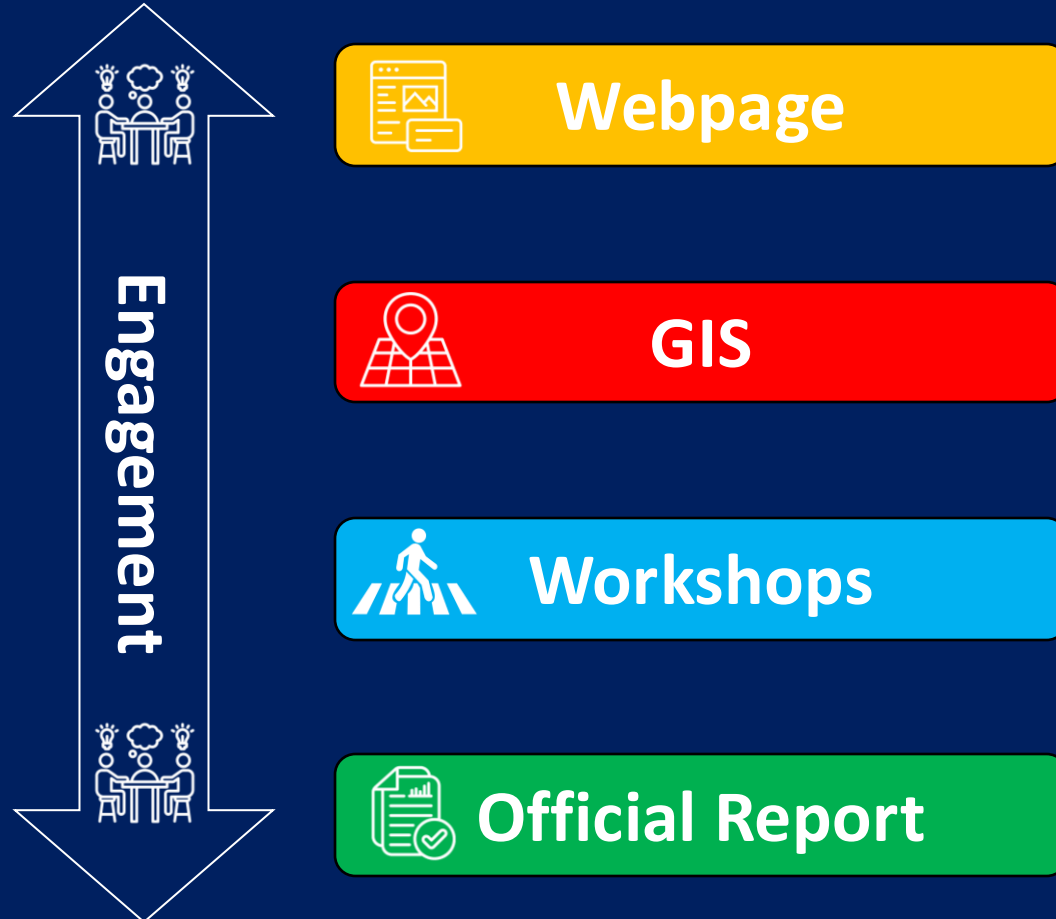
Walkable Community Workshops help communities engage in the planning process with AAMPO and other agencies to improve walking and cycling safety and accessibility.

AAMPO acts as a **facilitator**. We utilize planning expertise, stakeholder connections, and tools for communities to leverage.

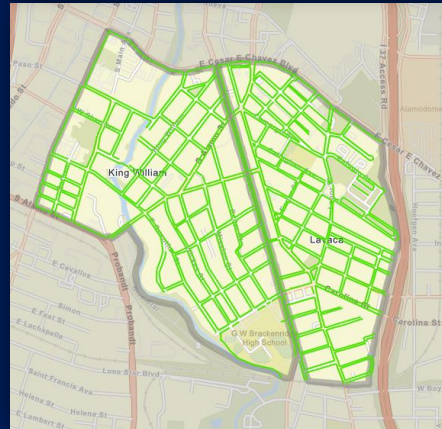
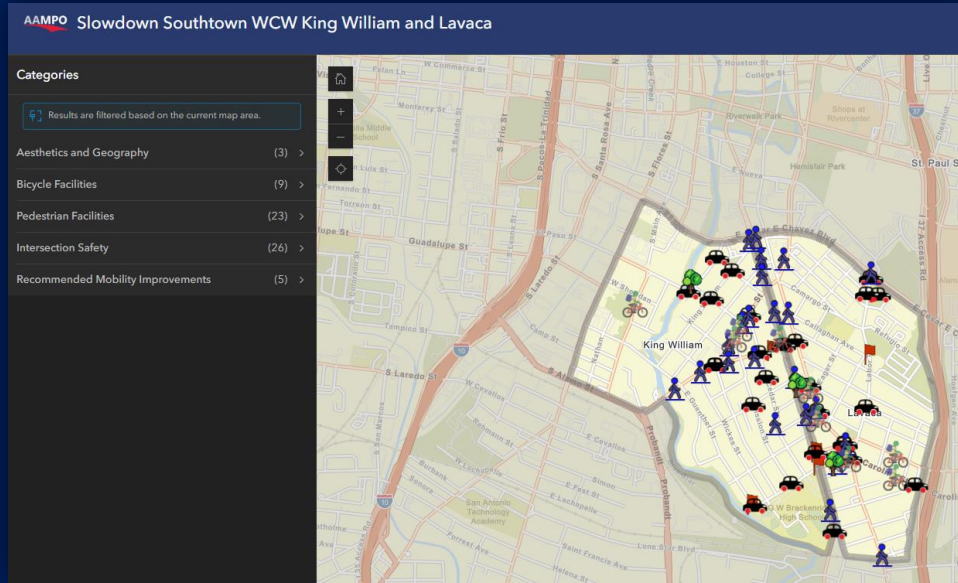
AAMPO then compiles and provides results, recommended improvements, and identifies funding opportunities and grants.

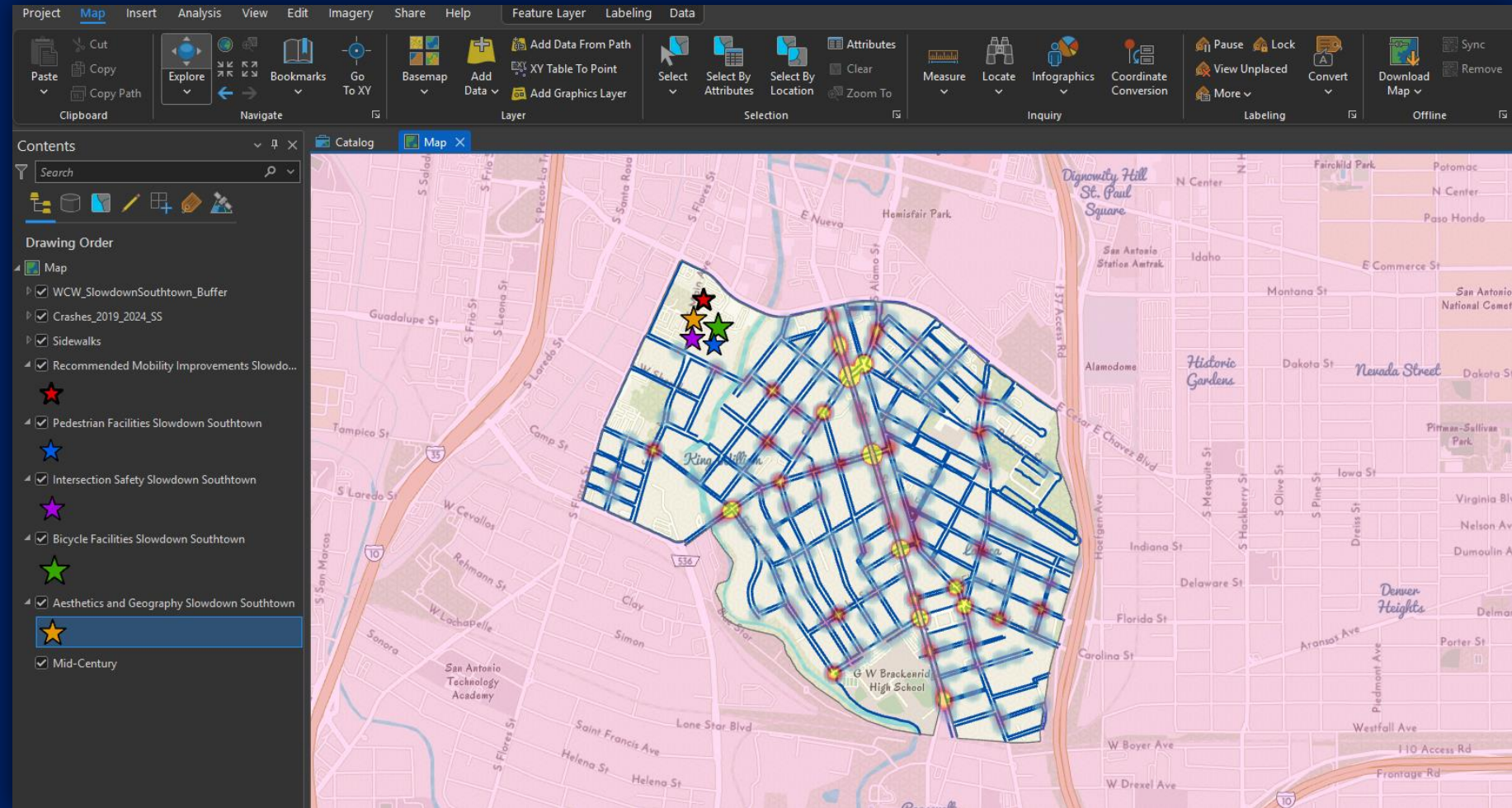
Recommended Mobility Improvements

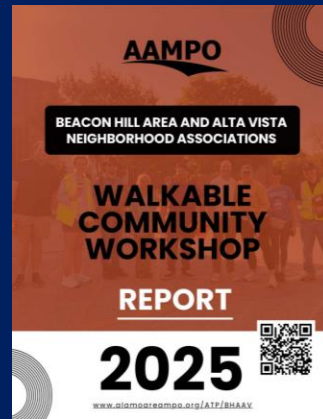
